### BENEFICIARY DESIGNATIONS

You may also list NCOF as the beneficiary of your bank accounts, retirement plan, pension plan, and life insurance. Contact your financial institution, plan administrator, or life insurance agent for the procedures required to revise your beneficiary designations.
