

Make Your Own Cardboard Loom

Materials:

- Cardboard Box
- Scissors
- Ruler (optional)
- Yarn or string



Steps:

1. Cut out a flat rectangle from your box
2. Make slits on opposite sides, approximately an inch apart and an inch deep (customize to your desires and do not worry about being exact). [See first image on bottom]
3. String yarn between the slits, taping the ends to the back. [See second image]
4. Cut about two feet of yarn or string, and attach one end by stringing it through a slit and taping it to the back. Start weaving the other end through the strings, under the first, over the second, and so on.
5. When you hit the edge of your loom, pull your yarn tight, loop it around the last string, and weave it back. Make sure that you are going over the strings you went under last time, and vice versa. [See third image]
6. Repeat until you run out of yarn, then tie on more (change the color to make stripes!) Once done, snip the strings attaching your creation to the loom. You can tie the ends together to create a fringe [see top image] Tuck in loose bits, and enjoy!
