



Don't be sheepish! Action required ahead of 2023 registration

Hello farm families!

If you are planning to register your child for *any* programs in 2023, whether or not you've attended programs with us before, action is required by you **as soon as possible, and ahead of program registration**. I estimate this will take 5 minutes of your time, including time spent reading this memo. This task is a one-time setup as part of a software transition.

Here's the scoop:

We are transitioning to a new registration software for our 2023 programs. The software is called Sawyer.

Once you have done this, **please pause. Do not register for any programs**. We need 1 - 2 business days to sync your information with our database, including applying your farm memberships, if any. (Again, this pause is a one-time setup as part of our software change.)

We will email you when your account is ready for registration.

- Registration for January and February, including February vacation, will be available immediately.
- Summer registration opens to Farm Members at the Crofter Level + on January 17, and to the public in mid-February.

Important notes:

- We may need more than 1-2 business days during our Holiday period: December 26 - January 2. We will still email you when your account is ready.
- Neglecting to set up your account ahead of January 17 **will result in a delay to your summer registration**, so it's possible your desired weeks/programs could sell out. If you plan to have your child/ren join us, please, please tend to the task above as soon as possible.
